The Camp Site

Feast has a brand new venue called the Camp Site. It's a relaxing little spot with an open fire, tents and marshmallows. The site is suitable for storytelling, acoustic music gigs, poetry readings, cooking demonstrations and anything else that would complement a camp site. There is the option to have ticketed events or free events, it's up to you! The site will be located in Light Square and

the flames will be burning for the entire festival.

The Patio

The Patio Stage is Feast's free outdoor stage. It will be located near the bar in the Feast Hub at Light Square and is open to emerging and established performance artists, musicians and DJ's. So if you want a chance to promote your show, play for the first time in front of sizable crowds, or just want to play some DJ tunes, then this is your chance. Feast will provide a basic sound set up, all you need to do is turn up with your own instruments, music or show! Oh, and feel free to make some money busking.

The Ballroom and The Lounge – Absolute Last Chance!

This is your last chance to secure a spot in one of our two top performance venues at the Feast Hub -

The Ballroom, our 200 seat circus tent, and The Lounge, our 120 seat cabaret style venue. Both venues cater for a variety of performance styles including cabaret, circus, theatre, dance, comedy and a variety of events.
