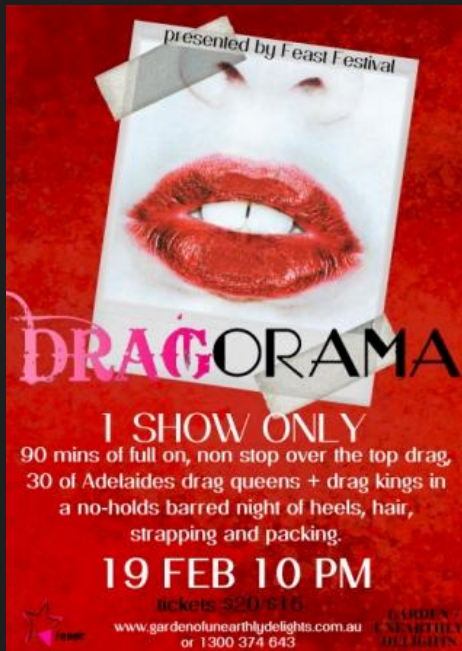

DeAnne Smith at The Fringe in 2012



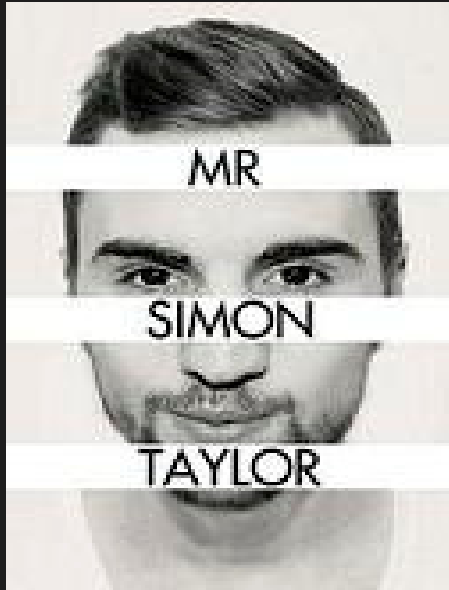

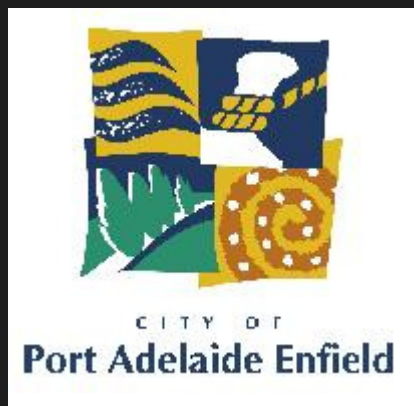
